Content	<p>This course focuses on Muamalah, which is part of the framework of Islamic teachings, namely Sharia. The discussion of muamalah is divided into two parts. First, muammalah in the narrow sense, namely, discussing the relationship between humans and humans in terms of fulfilling their material needs, such as economics. Muamalah in the narrow sense is divided into two parts, namely, muamalah madiyah and muamalah adabiyah. The muamalah madiyah is a discussion related to the object, for example, the validity of the contract used and the halalness of the object being traded. Meanwhile, muamalah adabiyah is a discussion related to the subject, for example, the absence of elements of fraud in a transaction, the existence of ethics in buying and selling, and so on. Second, Muamalah in broad terms discusses human relations with other humans in all aspects of life, such as marriage, inheritance,</p>
