Content	The research proposal serves as a preparatory step for students in drafting their final undergraduate thesis. The first half of this module is dedicated to providing material on developing. Chapters 1 to 3 of the research proposal, while the second half focuses on practical work in drafting the research proposal for the final project.

	<p>The Research Proposal is a document written by undergraduate students as part of their final bachelor's degree studies assignment. The proposal must be based on original research findings or a literature review that can be academically justified. The research proposal is implemented by students with the assistance of faculty members serving as supervisors. The structure and methodology for writing the research proposal are delivered through workshops conducted by experts and supported by a scientific writing guidebook.</p>
